Above All Else

- The teachers and staff really listen, and care.

- Playgrounds, classrooms, and the entrance of the building are clean and safe.

Health & Safety

- Is there an evacuation plan in case of emergency?
- Are there safe pickup/drop-off procedures?
- Does the entrance have a trustworthy security system?
- Are there caregivers on-site trained in first aid and CPR?
- Are outdoor play areas safely fenced in?
- Are the menus nutritious and food choices varied?
- Do caregivers follow hand-washing techniques?

Teachers & Staff

- Are teachers trained for the age group that they teach?
- Can you tell children are learning in the classroom?
- Do teachers interact with children—both in small-group and large-group activities?
- Did you feel comfortable with the person who will take care of your child?
- Did you feel the teachers would partner with you in developing your child?
- Did you feel you could speak openly with the Center Director about anything concerning you?

Curriculum

- Is the day carefully planned for your child?
- Is the program adaptable for various levels of development?
- Do children engage in a variety of activities throughout the day?
- Do children learn social skills—such as sharing, taking turns, and getting along with others?
- Do children have ample time to play and explore?
- Is play used as a way to learn?
- Is quality literature used in the classroom every day?
- Do children play outside every day (weather permitting)?

Infants & Toddlers

- Are there individual cribs for each infant?
- Are there strict guidelines for sanitizing toys and surfaces?
- Are the toys safe?
- Are care, meal, and nap times personalized for your child's needs?
- Are play and daily routines used as opportunities for nurturing and learning?
- Do the toys and materials offer interesting and challenging activities?
- Does the center feel cozy and familial?

Preschool & Pre-K

- Does the curriculum prepare your child for school?
- Is quality literature used in the classroom each day?
- Are children read to at least twice a day?
- Are writing materials available?
- Are a wide range of instructional methods used, like small-group learning, whole-group learning, and individual learning?
- Do children get a wide range of hands-on learning experiences?

Kindergarten & School Age

- Is safe and reliable transportation provided to and from school?
- Is there an area where children can do homework after school?
- Is there a variety of fun and engaging activities for children to choose from?
- Do both the classroom and outdoor play area encourage creativity and independence?
- Are extra activities offered—like music, fitness, and Spanish?
- Is private kindergarten available?
